# What We Have ACCOMPLISHED Since 2012



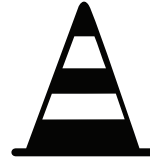
Assisted Invest Atlanta with Eastside Tax Allocation Facade Improvement Program Workshops for over 200 business owners resulting in grants valued over \$1M

Facilitated City of Atlanta's special use permits for Edgewood Avenue parking lots to allow monitored, paid evening parking and improved safety



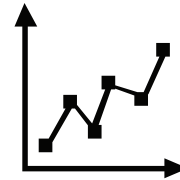
Serve on NPU-M Executive Committee and collaborate with all neighborhood associations within NPU-M

Mapped over 35 private business security cameras and have used in solving 3 crimes



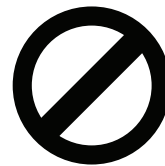

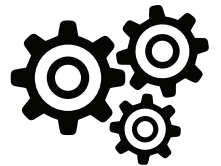
Installed 10 City of Atlanta Trash Cans
